Alexios Antypas is an Associate Professor at Central European University. He holds PhD in natural resources policy and sociology from University of Washington and MSc in environmental science from State University of New York College of Environmental Science and Forestry. His current research projects focus on environmental justice, the implementation of the Aarhus Convention in Eastern Europe, forest policy in the Baltic States, and transboundary environmental management in the Lake Ohrid region of Macedonia, Albania, and Greece. Alexios has worked with the Regional Environmental Center for Central and Eastern Europe on transboundary environmental governance issues related to the cyanide spill at Baia Mare, Romania, and is currently involved in a project with the REC on corporate environmental responsibility. He has also been a consultant for the US Forest Service and the US Bureau of Land Management on the social aspects of ecosystem management and participated in the social impact assessment of the Federal Ecosystem Management Assessment Team's analysis of forest policy in the Pacific Northwest of the US.

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Jens Wandel Jens leads the practice architecture underpinning UNDP's work in the Europe and CIS region. Prior to his current post, Jens was Global Management Practice Leader for UNDP and coordinated a corporate-wide accountability initiative. In 2001, Jens became Senior Management Adviser, providing leadership to a major business reengineering project for UNDP, the UN Population Fund (UNFPA) and the UN Office for Project Services (UNOPS). Among his key achievements, Jens introduced best-practice business processes and rolled out a global enterprise resource management system across these agencies. Jens began his career with UNDP in 1988 as a Junior Professional Officer in Western Samoa, followed by assignments in Viet Nam, Kyrgyzstan (Deputy Head of Office) and Turkmenistan (Head of Office). Jens focused on democratic governance, aid management, early recovery, financing for the poor, and advocacy for the United Nations values and programmes.

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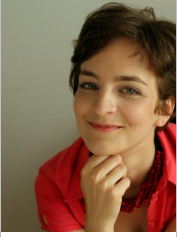
