

# CEU Online Summer course on LATIN AND GREEK CODICOLOGY AND PALAEOGRAPHY

6 July - 10 July 2020 – Budapest, Hungary

Application deadline: June 8, 2020

The Summer School is a one-week, intensive, real time (CET), fully interactive online course using Zoom. It comprises fifteen 90-minute sessions and gives a certificate of attendance and ECTS credits.



1. Intensive Latin and Greek **palaeography seminars** in parallel tracks at beginner and advanced levels focusing on the transcription of various scripts, practicing the dating of hands, looking at abbreviations and features of hands.
2. Instruction and practical assignments in **textual criticism** and **diplomats** provides a tool for research and editorial work.
3. **Lectures** in Latin and Greek **codicology** contextualise the intensive palaeography seminars and bring new insights into current research.
4. **Codicology assignments** and practical **palaeography test provide the feedback.**
5. Introduction to **online resources.**
6. **Individual consultation.**

**Target audience:** PhD and MA students and young researchers within the fields of Classics, Medieval Studies, Byzantine Studies, History and Theology.
