**PROGRAM COSTS**

**Tuition fee: 910 USD** - payable to [University of Maryland](#) (see details under “application”)

- An “early bird” fee of **800 USD** is available for students who enroll **prior to March 15, 2016**.
- A reduced fee of **680 USD** is available for current students, as well as those from a developing country. (“Early bird” students who enroll prior to March 15, 2016 benefit from a reduced fee of **575 USD**.)
- A reduced fee of **480 USD** is available for those who are employed by a small non-profit organization (annual turnover below 200,000 USD) or by the government of a developing country. (For “early bird” students, the fee is **375 USD**.)

Upon successful completion of the course, University of Maryland awards a Certificate of Completion. In addition, students will have the choice of taking the course for one ECTS credit and a Certificate of Completion from Central European University as well.

*This summer course is financed through tuition fees and will not be able to offer any scholarships or tuition waivers. The minimum enrollment required is 16 participants. The final deadline by which the course will be confirmed is March 15, 2016.*

**Accommodation in CEU Residence Center**

- In Single room: 28 EUR/ night / person - including breakfast
- In Shared Double room: 17 EUR/ night / person - including breakfast

**Estimated living costs: 120-150 EUR per week**
