TUITION FEE

- Standard fee: **400 EUR**
- Student Fee: **300 EUR**

We expect fees to be paid upon your confirmation of participation **until June 25, 2020**.

Faculty and Ph.D. students are advised to approach their home departments for a grant; researchers may have research grants available that can cover their participation, and professionals may turn to their employers to fund their training at SUN.

This summer course is financed through tuition fees. However, two tuition waivers will be allocated to highly qualified applicants who have no possibility to secure sufficient funding. If you would like to apply for one of the fee waivers, please tick the "Fee-paying package" on the "Funding page" in the online application system and upload a letter in the "Written Work" tab of the application form under the section of "Optional supplementary documents" in support of your request.

The final deadline by which the course will be confirmed is June 27, 2020.
