

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

PROGRAM COSTS

- Tuition Fee: **700 EUR** (Payable until April 25, 2020)
- Early Bird fee: **630 EUR** (Payable until April 10, 2020)

- Accommodation - **CEU Residence Center (45 minutes to CEU campus by public transportation)**
 - In single room: 28 EUR/ night / person - including breakfast
 - In shared double room: 17 EUR/ night / person - including breakfast

- Estimated living costs (per week): **120-160 EUR**

ISEPEI-SUN WEEKEND WORKSHOPS

This year a series of short spinoff workshops (<https://summeruniversity.ceu.edu/isepei-spinoff-workshops-2020>) will also be offered. These weekend workshops offer hands-on training on practical data management skills and insights into data-driven decision-making using various geospatial data innovations (data collection, manipulation, analysis and visualization techniques). One of the workshops will focus on innovations in post-disaster finance instruments and review their best practices around the globe.

After the course:

- Applications of Google Earth Engine (June 27-28)
- Geographic Information Systems (GIS) for the Humanitarian Community (June 27-28)
- Socio-Environmental Data Analysis and Visualization (June 27-28)

Participants paying the full fee for the *Innovations in Disaster Risk Reduction* course are eligible for reduced workshop fees.

FINANCIAL AID

The course is funded by CEU enabling participation at a low, subsidized tuition cost. As some applicants may have difficulty paying for tuition and/or some of the other associated costs (travel and accommodation), a **limited number of tuition waivers** will be offered on a competitive basis. **No travel or accommodation grants are available for this course.**

Those who wish to apply for a tuition waiver should specify their reasons in the “Personal statement on financial aid” section (Funding page of the application form).

Faculty and Ph.D. students are advised to approach their home departments for travel grants; researchers may have research grants available that can cover their participation, and professionals may turn to their employers to fund their training at SUN. You can also consult some non-CEU funding opportunities listed in our **FAQ SECTION**.

In case an applicant is accepted to two courses, which is possible if the two courses are not overlapping, financial aid is only available for attending one course.

SUN PACKAGES

All packages include the following:

- a minimum of 24 tuition hours per week
- ECTS credits (<https://summeruniversity.ceu.edu/courses/credits>)
- a certificate of attendance

- access to course E-learning page (with readings, assignments, etc.)
- access to CEU facilities (Library, IT services, sports center at CEU Residence Center including the use of the indoor swimming pool and tennis courts)
- some social and cultural events depending on the course schedules (e.g. welcome and farewell reception / outings /field trips / film screenings, etc.)
