PROGRAM COSTS

- Tuition Fee:
 - **400 EUR** ("Early Bird" fee: **360 EUR**) for participants from academia and NGOs
 - **900 EUR** ("Early Bird" fee: **820 EUR**) for participants from business, public bodies & administrations and international organisations.

Tuition waivers are available to excellent candidates, especially from developing countries and countries in transition. The decision to waive tuition is made by the course organizers on a case-by-case basis.
- Self-funded participants can book accommodation at CEU Residence Center at special SUN rates (single room: 28 EUR/ night / person - including breakfast; shared double room: 17 EUR / night / person - including breakfast) via the *Housing form*, for which the link will be provided in the email notification letter. In case participants prefer to stay elsewhere, they can [CLICK HERE](#) to explore alternative accommodation options for apartment rentals or hotels.
- Estimated living costs: **150 - 200 EUR**

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid can be available to a very limited number of participants from developing countries, subject to funding availability from course sponsors in the following categories:

- accommodation grant
- travel grant (full or partial)

SUN PACKAGES

All packages will include the following:

- a minimum of 24 tuition hours per week
 - ECTS credits (<https://summeruniversity.ceu.edu/courses/credits>)
 - a certificate of attendance
- access to course E-learning page (with readings, assignments, etc.)
- access to CEU facilities (Library, IT services, sports center at the CEU Residence Center including the use of the indoor swimming pool, tennis courts)
- some social and cultural events depending on the course schedule (e.g. welcome and farewell reception / outings / fieldtrips / film screenings, etc.)

1. Fee-Paying Package

- Financial aid: N/A
- Participant's own contribution: tuition, travel, accommodation, health insurance and living expenses

Payment deadlines

- April 30 (Early Bird fee)
- May 28 (Full tuition fee)

Cancellation Policy

In the event of cancellation, CEU will refund the tuition fee as follows:

- Before May 28 - CEU will fully refund the full tuition fee paid.
- Between May 28th and 14 days prior to the course starting - 80% of the tuition fee will be refunded.
- Within 14 days of the course starting - no refund for tuition fees will be given.

2. Financial Aid packages

- ***Tuition Waiver***

- Financial aid: tuition fee waived to excellent participants, mostly from developing countries
- Participant's own contribution: health insurance, travel, accommodation and living expenses.

- ***Partial SUN or EEA Scholarship***

- Financial aid: tuition fee waived and free accommodation (available on an exceptional basis to a very limited number of participants from non-OECD countries, subject to the availability of funds)
- Participant's own contribution: health insurance, travel and living expenses

- ***Full Scholarship***

- Financial aid: tuition fee waived; free accommodation and a full or partial travel grant (available on exceptional basis to a very limited number of candidates from non-OECD countries, subject to the availability of funds)
- Participant's own contribution: health insurance and living expenses.

The notification about tuition waivers will be included in the acceptance letter; the decision about partial or full scholarships will be circulated within two weeks upon the acceptance.
