### PROGRAM COSTS

- Tuition Fee: **550 EUR** (Early Bird fee: **500 EUR**)
- Accommodation in CEU Residence Center:
  - In single room: **28 EUR/** night / person - including breakfast
  - In shared double room: **17 EUR/** night / person - including breakfast
- Estimated living costs: **240 - 280 EUR**

### FINANCIAL AID

#### Open Society University Network scholarships:

The Open Society University Network is offering 12 scholarships covering tuition accommodation, and travel, fieldtrip costs as well as a stipend on a competitive basis. Only currently enrolled students and employees of [OSUN member institutions](#) are eligible for the scholarship. Please indicate in the online form (Personal Details page) if you are enrolled or employed by one of the OSUN institutions.

#### CIVICA - The European University of Social Sciences

Currently enrolled students of CIVICA are eligible for a tuition waiver if admitted. Please indicate in the online form (Personal Details page) if you are enrolled at one of the CIVICA member institutions.

#### Max Weber Centre of the University of Erfurt scholarships

Doctoral students applying for this course can apply for refund of travel and accommodation expenses from a grant provided by the Max Weber Centre of the University of Erfurt.

Advanced BA and MA students can also apply for travel and accommodation grants available in a limited number.

You can indicate your scholarship request in the online application form (Funding page)

Faculty and Ph.D. students, in general, are advised to approach their home departments for travel grants; researchers may have research grants available that can cover their participation, and professionals may turn to their employers to fund their training at SUN.

In case an applicant is accepted into two courses, which is possible if the two courses are not overlapping, financial aid is only available for attending one course.

### SUN PACKAGES

All packages include the following:

- a minimum of 24 tuition hours per week
- 3 ECTS credits
- a certificate of attendance
- access to course E-learning page (with readings, assignments, etc.)
- a 3-day fieldtrip to Prague, 4 nights' accommodation and travel covered
- access to CEU facilities (Library, IT services, sports centre including the use of the indoor swimming pool, and tennis courts)
- some social and cultural events depending on the course schedules (e.g., welcome and farewell reception / outings / fieldtrips in and around Budapest/ film screenings, etc.)

## 1. Fee-Paying Package

Financial aid: N/A

Participant's own contribution: tuition, travel, accommodation for 7 nights in Budapest, health insurance and living expenses

### Payment deadlines

- April 30 (Early Bird fee)
- May 28 (Full tuition fee)

### Cancellation Policy

Cancellation by Participant: CEU will refund the tuition fee as follows:

- Before May 28 - CEU will refund 90% of the full tuition fee paid.
- Between May 28th and 14 days prior to the course starting - 50% of the tuition fee will be refunded.
- Within 14 days of the course starting - no refund for tuition fees will be given.

Cancellation by CEU Summer University (SUN):

CEU SUN reserves the right to cancel any of the courses. In such cases, CEU will refund the whole amount.
