

HOW TO APPLY

Please read the following directions carefully and before starting the application process.

Below is the list of the documents you need to prepare or arrange for submission:

1. **Completed online Application Form**
2. **Letter of recommendation**
3. A full **curriculum vitae or resume**, including a **list of publications**, if any
4. **Statement of Purpose** (not more than 500 words)
5. **Research proposal** (not more than 1000 words)

Optional attachments:

- A copy of an article in English published recently (if available)
 - A copy of an English language certificate (if available)

1. Online Application Form

SUN's Online Application Form, delivered by Embark, enables the online submission of the application form itself as well as all other relevant documentation, including CV's and resumes, letter of recommendation, statements of purpose and application essays (such as research proposal, case study, paper proposal, writing samples, academic records, etc.), eliminating all paper mailing to the SUN Office.

In addition, applicants will be able to use this system to track their progress and learn the outcome of their admissions evaluation online. Admissions decisions will be available to applicants as soon as they are entered into the system.

Please note that you can only apply to one course.

Detailed user's instructions for the online application are included in the form itself. Should you have questions regarding the application form, check the relevant [Frequently Asked Questions](#) section of the Summer University web site.

2. Letter of Recommendation

Applicants must have one letter of recommendation submitted. Please arrange for a letter of recommendation to be written by a referee (faculty member, job supervisor, etc.) who can attest to your abilities, qualifications and academic/professional performance. Please advise the referee about the title and content of the course you are applying to. The letter must be completed in English and submitted by the referees online via the online application facility.

3. A full curriculum vitae or resume, including a list of publications, if any

4. Statement of Purpose (not more than 500 words)

In the Statement of Purpose, please describe how the course is relevant to your research, teaching, or professional work, and in what way you expect to benefit from your participation. Please consult the detailed course description on the course web page so that the statement of purpose is in accordance with the main objectives of the course. Also, please list previous courses you have taken or describe any previous experience that you had related to the course theme.

5. Research proposal (not more than 1000 words)

a) Please describe your current research interest as it relates to the course theme. The proposal should contain the purpose, methodology, a brief outline of the key argument of the paper, expected output, and bibliography of your current or planned research at your home institution. During the course, the proposal will be discussed and further developed through consultations with the faculty and fellow participants.

b) WORKING GROUPS

Please include a statement about which part of the course is of particular interest:

- History of Moral Intuitionism
- Epistemology of Moral Intuitions
- Ethical Intuitionism

During the course, students are going to form smaller working groups and will concentrate on discussing issues related to these particular topics.

c) PRESENTATION OPPORTUNITIES

There will be opportunities for selected participants to give a short talk (20 minutes) or do poster presentations during the summer school. Please indicate in your research proposal whether you would be interested in doing a talk or presenting a poster. The selection will be based on the quality of the research proposal.
