FINANCIAL INFORMATION

PROGRAM COSTS

This summer course is financed through tuition fees and will not be able to offer any scholarships or tuition waivers. The final deadline by which the course will be confirmed is May 14, 2020.

TUITION FEE:

We expect fees to be paid only upon your confirmation of participation after April 15.

*There is a possibility for institutions to replace their initial nominees after the payment of the registration fee.

Erasmus+ Staff Mobility Grants can also be used to cover participants' costs and tuition fees. Please, consult with your Erasmus coordinator on the availability of Erasmus Staff Mobility Grants at your university, and on your institution's deadlines for mobility grant applications¹.

All packages include the following:

- a minimum of 24 tuition hours per week
- ECTS credits (<https://summeruniversity.ceu.edu/courses/credits>)
- a certificate of attendance
- access to course E-learning page (with readings, assignments, etc.)
- access to CEU facilities (Library, IT services, sports centre at CEU Residence Center including the use of the indoor swimming pool, tennis courts)

Refund policy

Cancellation by participant

In the event of cancellation, CEU will refund the tuition fee as follows:

- Before April 30 - CEU will refund 90% of the tuition fee paid.
- Between May 1 and May 28 - 50% of the tuition fee will be refunded.
- Within 30 days of the course starting - no refund for tuition fees will be given.

Cancellation by CEU Summer University (SUN)

CEU SUN reserves the right to cancel the course. In this case, CEU summer school will refund 100% of the fee paid. Participants should not purchase tickets or book non-refundable accommodations before the confirmation date, as the summer school can only reimburse the fee but no other costs.
